

# Sportbot Privacy Policy and Cookie Policy

## Information about the company and the Site

This Privacy Policy and Cookie Policy (hereinafter: "Privacy Policy") describes the way in which BIOFLEKS d.o.o. (hereinafter: "Company", "us", "we" or "our") collects, processes, and shares the information and data you provide to us by using <https://sportbot.tech> (hereinafter: "Site") and when you use or buy Company's products.

A customer is any legal or natural person who uses or visits the Site or buys our products and services (hereinafter: "the customer"). The controller of personal data within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the applicable Slovenian legislation on personal data protection is BIOFLEKS d.o.o., Rojska cesta 19, 1230 Domžale, Slovenia, registration number: 3734064000, VAT ID: SI 83272399 (hereinafter: "controller").

In addition to the Privacy Policy, we ask you to also familiarize yourself with the General Terms and Conditions (hereinafter: "Terms") governing the business relationship between the customer (you as Site visitors and as customers of our services and products) and the controller.

We will only use the personal information collected on the Site as set out in this Privacy Policy. Below you will find information on how we use your personal information, for what purposes your personal information is used, with whom we share it, and what control and information rights you have.

By using the Site, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of your information (including personal information) in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We receive and/or may ask you to provide your information (including personal information) whenever you are in contact with us or use the Site. As detailed below, we share your information (including personal information) with third parties (as detailed below) and use it in ways consistent with this Privacy Policy. We may use your information (including personal information) in conjunction with other information to provide and improve products, services, and content.

With this document, the Company informs you of our Privacy Policy, practices, and your choices about how we collect your information online and how we use that information. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and revisit this page from time to time to review any possible changes.

The Company may change this Privacy Policy at any time by posting the changed terms on this page. All amended terms will automatically take effect on the date specified in the Privacy Policy unless otherwise specified.

## **Summary of our processing activities**

The following summary gives you a quick overview of the processing activities carried out on our Site. For more information see the sections below.

- Limited personal information is processed when you visit our Site for informational purposes only and without purchasing our services or products.
- If you buy our products or use our services further personal data will be processed as part of such services.
- Furthermore, your personal information will be used to provide advertising for our services, products and statistical analysis to help us improve our Site; in addition, we improve your experience of our Site with third-party content.
- Your personal data may be disclosed to third parties located outside your country of residence, potentially applying different data protection standards.
- We have put in place appropriate safeguards to protect your personal information, which we only keep for as long as necessary.
- In accordance with the law applicable to you, you may be entitled to exercise certain rights in relation to the processing of your personal data.

## **Sites covered by the Privacy Policy**

This Privacy Policy applies to <https://sportbot.tech>. The Company's Site may have links to third party websites for easier reading and more information. By accessing these links, you will leave the Company's Site. We do not control these sites, and their privacy policies may differ from ours. This Privacy Policy does not cover any personal information you choose to give to unrelated third parties. We do not monitor or control the information collected by such sites or compliance with third-party privacy policies, and we are not responsible for their conduct or the content of their websites.

## **Definitions**

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, "personal data" or "personal information" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual that can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by an identifier such as name, identification number, location data, online identifier, or by indicating one or more factors specific to that individual's physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity. In some countries, "personal data" or "personal information" does not include business contact information.

"Processing" means any act or series of actions carried out in relation to personal data or sets of personal data, with or without automated means, such as collecting, recording, editing, structuring, storing, adapting or modifying, retrieving, viewing, using, disclosure by brokering, expanding or otherwise making available, adapting or combining, restricting, deleting or destroying.

## **General use of the Site**

Through the Site, you can buy our products or use our services as set out in the Terms (view information about the service, or request support information). Every time you purchase our product or service, we will ask you for certain information.

To understand the provisions of this Privacy Policy, we distinguish between two types of use which are depending on how you use the Site:

- informative use of the Site and
- use of the Site to buy our products or services.

## **Informative use of the Site**

If you visit our Site for informational reasons, i.e. without providing personal data in any form, we may automatically collect information about you, that will contain personal information only in limited cases as it is automatically recognized by our server. This information for example is:

- the site from which you were directed to our Site;
- the date and time of your claims;
- products you have added to cart;
- device type, screen resolution, and browser version;
- your internet service provider;
- information about your operating system, including language settings;
- information about the offers you have visited on our Site.

We use this information (i) to assist us in providing efficient services (e.g. to tailor our Site to the needs of your device), (ii) to notify you about changes to our services and products, (iii) to allow you to participate in interactive features of our service when you choose to do so, (iv) to provide customer support, (v) to monitor the usage of our service and (vi) in order to detect, prevent and address technical issues.

The personal information we collect automatically, is necessary to secure the Site and for our legitimate interest in ensuring the stability and security of the Site.

Personal data that is collected automatically is immediately anonymized and all personally identifiable data is deleted accordingly.

## **Use of the Site to buy our products and services**

Our e-commerce functionality is provided by a third-party provider WooCommerce. If you visit our Site for the purpose of buying our products or services, we process, in connection with such use of the Site, the following information:

- your name, surname, address, telephone, and email;
- communications you have sent (e.g. via email or communication forms on the Site);

We will use personal information so that our services and products can be made available to you and so that we can provide the required information or communicate with you.

The personal data we collect is necessary for the performance of contractual obligations between the customer and the controller (processing on the basis of law and contractual relations) as well as for our legitimate interest.

We will not store or collect your payment card details. That information is provided directly to our third-party payment processors whose use of your personal information is governed by their privacy policy. These payment processors adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover. PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of payment information.

### **Collection of financial data**

When buying our services or products, we need your financial information (such as credit card number, billing address and expiration date). The entire payment process will be made through an external payment service provider (Stripe or PayPal) outside the Company's site. We do not store the financial data obtained from you and use them only to process the payment and issue a payment confirmation for the service via Stripe or PayPal service. The mentioned Stripe services are regulated by the legal documentation of the provider, which is available at <https://stripe.com/en-si/privacy>. The mentioned PayPal services are regulated by the legal documentation of the provider, which is available at <https://www.paypal.com/en/webapps/mpp/ua/privacy-full>.

In the case of payment by bank transfer, the Company stores your data as long as required by law. When you make a payment by bank transfer, we see the name and number of the bank account from which the money was sent on the bank statement. This information can be used to identify the order that was paid to process that order.

### **Collection of other information**

In most cases you agree to the use of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy by providing this information to us. In some cases, we specifically ask for your explicit consent if we believe the information is sensitive, or that our use of the information includes other uses not covered by this Privacy Policy or other privacy notices we have made available to you.

### **Newsletter**

We use MailChimp to manage our email marketing subscriber list and to send emails to our subscribers. MailChimp is a third-party provider, which may process your data using industry-standard technologies to help us monitor and improve our newsletter. MailChimp's privacy policy is available at <https://www.intuit.com/privacy/statement/>.

With your email address, you can subscribe to our newsletter and agree to regularly receive it. The newsletter provides you with the latest information about our services and products and may also contain advertisements related to our services. The legal basis for processing is your consent. Your email address will be kept for the time of your subscription to our newsletter. You can unsubscribe from this service at any time by clicking "unsubscribe" at the foot of each newsletter received or send us an email at [info@sportbot.tech](mailto:info@sportbot.tech). In the subject of the email please write "Unsubscription from a newsletter". We will respond to your request within 72 hours of receiving your email.

### **Company's messages**

When you buy our services or products, we'll send you a confirmation e-mail to verify your order. We answer your questions, provide custom services, and manage your account. We will communicate with you by e-mail and strive to respect your wishes.

If you want to subscribe to our newsletter, we will use your name and email address to send newsletters. You can subscribe to our newsletter on our subscription page. You can unsubscribe at any time (see the Unsubscribe section below).

If necessary, the Company will send you notifications related to non-promotional services. If you do not wish to receive them, you can unsubscribe from receiving such notifications.

Please note that we provide your email address only to those of our business partners who need it in order to guarantee that our Site is functioning normally so you can use our services and products without any problems.

### **Exchange of information**

The Company does business with other service providers and suppliers in order to provide the comprehensive range of services and solutions as described above. These service providers may change their offer or sign a contract with additional service providers to better meet the needs of our customers.

Your personal data will be disclosed to third parties only to the extent necessary to fulfill our contractual relationship. The legal basis for the transfer of your personal data are points (b) and (f) of Article 6 (1) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation as they also represent our legitimate interest in enforcing our general terms and conditions or other contracts concluded with you. We may transfer your personal information to other countries for the purposes of data consolidation, storage, simplified customer information management and reporting.

We may disclose anonymous aggregate statistics about our Site customers to potential partners, advertisers and other reputable third parties for the purpose of describing our services and other legitimate purposes. However, such information will not contain any personal information.

We may disclose your personal information to our contractors who assist us in providing the services we offer through the Site. Such transfer will always be based on a personal data processing agreement, which means that our contractors will only use your personal data to the

extent necessary to perform their functions and will be contractually obliged to process your personal data only on our behalf and in accordance with our requirements.

The Company does not disclose personal information to third parties for its own use without your permission. However, the Company must share information in some cases as a result of applicable law. For example, we must disclose information due to a court order, testimony, or judicial investigation. In addition, we may voluntarily provide information in accordance with applicable law to assist in the investigation of law enforcement, or if disclosure is necessary to protect our systems, our business, or the rights of others.

### **Cross-border data transmission**

As part of the above data exchange activities, your personal data may be transferred to other countries (such as the US), which may have different data protection standards from the country in which you reside. Please note that data processed in a foreign country may be subject to foreign laws and be accessible to foreign governments, courts, law enforcement agencies and regulatory agencies. Notwithstanding the foregoing, we will endeavor to take reasonable steps to maintain an appropriate level of data protection in the exchange of your personal data with such countries.

### **Unsubscribe**

### **Access to and accuracy of your information**

We provide you with access to your information, including online access and the opportunity to change your information if possible. To protect your privacy and security, we will verify your identity with appropriate measures, such as your password and username, before you are given permission to access your information. In accordance with applicable law and our Terms, we reserve the right to refuse visitors the access of our Site. In such cases, we will give the concerned visitor the reason why he/she was refused access.

### **Security of your data**

To protect against the loss, misuse and alteration of personal data, we have introduced reasonable state-of-the-art security measures that are under our control. For example, our security and private policies are regularly reviewed and improved as needed, and only

authorized personnel have access to personal information. While we cannot guarantee that information will never be lost, misused or altered, we use all reasonable efforts to prevent it.

The Company does not guarantee the security of our servers, nor can we guarantee that the information you send to the Site will not be intercepted while being transmitted over the Internet. We use generally accepted technical standards to protect the personal information you provide to us, both during transfer and after receipt. When you enter sensitive information (such as credit card information) when making a payment, we use the PayPal service to encrypt that information using the Secure Socket Layer cryptographic protocol.

You need to keep in mind that sending information over the internet is never completely secure. We cannot guarantee the security of the information you send through our Site, even if they are in transit over the internet and any transmission is at your own risk.

### **Data storage**

We strive to keep our processing of your personal data as limited as possible. If there are no retention periods specified in this Privacy Policy, your personal information will only be stored for as long as we need it to fulfill the purpose for which we collected it and, if necessary, for as long as the statutory retention period requires it.

For customers that register on our Site, we also store the personal information they provide in their user profile. All customers can see, edit, or delete their own personal information at any time except they cannot change their username. Site administrators can also see and edit that information.

### **What rights you have regarding your personal data**

If you have any questions regarding our Privacy Policy or the processing of your personal information, you may contact us without hesitation. Write to us at [info@sportbot.tech](mailto:info@sportbot.tech). Upon your request, we will inform you - in writing and in accordance with the applicable law.

In accordance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights as an individual:

- **Right to withdraw consent:** If you, as an individual, have consented to the processing of your personal data (for one or more specific purposes), you have the right to revoke your consent at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the data processing carried out up to your revocation. Consent may be revoked by a written statement sent to the controller at one of the contacts listed on the Site <https://sportbot.tech>. Withdrawal of consent to our processing of personal data does not have any negative consequences or sanctions for the individual. However, after revoking the consent to our processing of personal data, the controller may no longer be able to provide one or more of its services to the concerned individual if the services cannot be provided without personal data.

- **Right of access:** As an individual, you have the right to obtain a confirmation from the provider (personal data controller) whether personal data is processed in relation to you and, where applicable, access to personal data and certain information (on the purposes of processing, on the types of personal data, about the users, on retention periods or criteria for determining periods, on the existence of the right to rectify or delete data, the right to limit and object to processing and the right to appeal to the supervisory authority, the source of data if the data have not been collected from you, the existence of automated decision making, including the creation of profiles, the reasons for it and the meaning and consequences of such processing for you, and other information in accordance with Article 15 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation).
  
- **Right to correct personal information:** As an individual, you have the right to have the controller correct inaccurate personal data about you without undue delay. As an individual, you have the right to supplement incomplete data, including the submission of a supplementary statement, taking into account the purposes of the processing.
  
- **Data deletion (“the right to forget”):** As an individual, you have the right to request deletion of the personal information that the controller holds about you. The controller must delete the data without undue delay when there is one of the following reasons:
  - data are no longer needed for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
  - if you revoke the consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing;
  - if you object to the processing and there are no overriding legitimate reasons for the processing;
  - the data were processed illegally;
  - the data must be deleted in order to fulfill legal obligations under EU law or the law of the Member State applicable to the controller;
  - data were collected in connection with the provision of information society services.

However, as an individual, in certain cases described in Article 17 (3) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation, you do not have the right to have the data deleted.

- **Restriction of processing:** You have the right to request the controller to restrict the processing of your personal data where:
  - you contest the accuracy of the personal data until the controller has taken sufficient steps to correct or verify its accuracy;
  - the processing is unlawful but you do not want the controller to erase the data;
  - the controller no longer needs your personal data for the purposes of the processing, but you require such data for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims; or
  - you have objected to processing justified on legitimate interest grounds (see above) pending verification as to whether the controller has overriding compelling legitimate grounds to continue processing.

- **Data portability:** You, as an individual, have the right to receive personal data about you that you have provided to the controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and also to require the controller to transmit it to another controller where this is technically feasible. Namely when:
  - processing is based on consent or a contract, and
  - processing is carried out by automated means.
  
- **Right to object:** On grounds relating to your specific situation, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data that is necessary to perform tasks in the public interest or exercise public authority conferred on the controller (point (e) of Article 6 (1) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation) or is necessary for legitimate interests pursued by the controller or a third party (point (f) of Article 6 (1) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation), including profiling on the basis of those treatments. The controller ceases to process personal data unless it proves urgent legitimate reasons for the processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or for asserting, enforcing or defending legal claims.

Where personal data are processed for marketing purposes, the individual has the right to object at any time to the processing of data relating to him/her for the purposes of such marketing, including the creation of profiles, insofar as it relates to such direct marketing. Where an individual objects to processing for direct marketing purposes, the data shall no longer be processed for those purposes.

Where data is processed for scientific or historical research purposes or for statistical purposes, the individual has the right to object to the processing of data relating to him/her for reasons related to his/hers particular situation, unless the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out by reasons of public interest.

- **Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority:** Without prejudice to any other (administrative or other) remedy, you, as an individual, have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, in particular in the country where you have your habitual residence, where you work or where the infringement allegedly took place, if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the regulations on the protection of personal data. In Slovenia, the tasks of the supervisory authority are performed by the Information Commissioner.

Without prejudice to any other (administrative or extrajudicial) remedy, you as an individual have the right to an effective remedy against a legally binding decision of the supervisory authority, as well as in the event that the supervisory authority does not consider your complaint or does not inform you about the situation or the decision on the appeal within three months. Proceedings against the supervisory authority shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of the Member State in which the supervisory authority is established.

The individual may address all requests concerning the exercise of rights in relation to personal data in writing to the controller by sending an email at [info@sportbot.tech](mailto:info@sportbot.tech).

The controller may, for the purposes of identification of the individual in case of exercising his/her rights in relation to personal data, request additional data from the individual and may refuse to act, if the individual cannot be reliably identified.

The controller must respond to the request of the individual by which he/she exercises his/her rights in relation to personal data without undue delay and no later than one month from the receipt of the request.

## Cookie Policy

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your computer by a web page or app that you visit. It helps the Site to identify you when you return to a Site and to provide us with information about your activities when you are visiting the Site. Cookies are collecting information about your usage of the webpage and information about your device, with which you are accessing the Site. For the purpose of this Policy “information” means your IP address, type of web browser, demographic data, time of visit, the reference site, applicator or service from which you were directed to our Site, access to the Site, the URL click flow (the chronological order of our Site you’ve visited).

There are different types of cookies. From the perspective of their life span (for how long they are stored on your computer) cookies can be “session” or “persistent”. Session cookies are stored only for a period of time when you are visiting the Site and are automatically deleted as soon as you close your web browser or app. On the other side, persistent cookies remain on your computer when you have gone offline. They are stored on your device (computer, mobile phone) for a certain period of time and are reactivated every time you visit the Site where the cookies were created.

Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a customer, but personal information that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

We use cookies for:

- authentication (to identify you when you visit our website and as you navigate the website)
- personalization (if you so choose)
- security
- advertising (to display advertising and serve ads relevant to you)
- analysis (to help us analyze the use and performance of our website and services)

## What cookies do we use?

**Necessary cookies:** these cookies are crucial because they allow you to move around the website and use the functions of the website or provide the required service. The Company

does not need the customer's permission to use these cookies, so they are always installed on the device. They are set when the customer makes any interaction with the website.

**Web analytics cookies:** these cookies help the company understand how customers use websites. With their help, the Company improves the customer's experience and identifies customer's requirements and trends. These cookies are used by the Company only if the customer agrees to this.

**Target cookies or third-party advertising cookies:** These cookies are used to deliver ads that are more relevant to the customer and his interests. They are also used to limit the number of times an individual ad is displayed, as well as to help measure the effectiveness of an advertising campaign. They are usually installed by ad networks with the permission of the website operator. They remember that the customer visited the website and this information is passed on to other organizations such as advertisers. Targeted or advertising cookies are often associated with website functionality provided by another organization. These include social media cookies (eg Facebook, Google).

Depending on the web analytics tool provider, data obtained about your use of the Site may be downloaded and processed in third countries, e.g. in the United States. For more information on the potential risks of cross-border data transfer, see the "Cross-border Data Transfer" section of this Privacy Policy. These tools only collect the IP address assigned to you on the date of your visit to our Site, not your name or other identifying information. Providers of such tools will use this information to evaluate your use of the Site, to compile reports on Site activity and to provide other services related to the use of the Site.

The legal basis for this type of data processing is our legitimate interest in analyzing the traffic on our Site, improving the customer's experience and optimizing the Site in general.

On our behalf, Google will use the information generated by the cookie to evaluate your use of the Site, to compile reports on Site activity and to provide other services relating to Site activity and internet activity in connection with Site usage. Within Google Analytics, we have activated IP anonymization and your IP address will be truncated within the territory of the Member States of the European Union or other parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only exceptionally, the entire IP address will first be transferred to a Google server in the United States and truncated there. The IP address displayed by your browser as part of Google Analytics will not be associated with other data held by Google.

Google's rights to use and share the information it obtains through Google Analytics are defined in accordance with the following documents: [Google Analytics Terms of Use](#) and [Google Privacy Policy](#).

You can disable Google Analytics from recognizing you the next time you visit a Site by disabling the use of cookies in your web browser; however, keep in mind that if you do, you may not be able to use the full functionality of the Site. In addition, you can prevent the collection of information generated by the cookie about your use of the Site (including your IP address) and the processing of this information by Google by downloading and installing a browser plug-in available at the following link: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>.

## - **Facebook Pixel**

We use Facebook Pixel to better track the traffic we receive from Facebook, and to measure the effectiveness of ads and sponsored posts. Facebook pixel will place more cookies on your device if you agree to third-party cookies on our website. ## **Unsubscribe from web analytics**

## **Accounts on the Site**

If you have an account and you log in to the Site, we will set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal information and is discarded when you close your browser.

When you log in, we will set additional cookies so that we can store your login information and language selection. Login cookies last for the duration of your visit / session and are deleted when you leave the website. Language selection cookies are deleted after 24 hours.

If you edit or publish an article, an additional cookie will be saved in your browser. This cookie includes no personal data and simply indicates the post ID of the article you just edited. It expires after 1 day.

## **Instructions for Editing Cookies in Individual Browsers**

If you want to change the settings for cookies in your browser, including blocking or deleting them, you can do so by changing your browser settings accordingly. For management, most browsers allow you to accept or reject all cookies, accept only a certain type of cookie, or alert you that the site wants to store a cookie. You can also easily delete cookies stored by the browser. If you change or delete your browser's cookie file, change or upgrade your browser or device, you may need to disable cookies again.
